Oct 4,

1918

Hello Mother;

Well I got your jelly all right but have not received the two packages you said you sent. I suppose I will get them tomorrow though. If you have any eats to send I will be glad to get them as even the canteens are closed on account of the quarantine. I got a new job again working nights. They put us on a job taking care of sick soldiers in the W. C. hall. The funny part of it is there are no soldiers here yet so we stick stuck around and write letters and then eat at eleven thirty, come back again and do whatever we darn please and then beat it for camp about 2 o'clock in the morning and sleep some more. They have five tents for us night men to sleep in the day time so I got it pretty soft until the quarantine is lifted. If any one comes in our tent we tell them what hard work we do so that is all there is to it. I believe I gave you my stamps with that bunch of letters I gave you and as I haven't a cent please send me some more stamps. Every one is disgusted with this quarantine as we can't get out to see any thing except except the darned tents. I am
