"TICKLER, BOONE'S BEST FRIEND" (pictured above) is the rifle Daniel Boone used with him in 1780 as he followed the Indian trail known as Wagon's Path across the Cumberland Gap and into the wilderness beyond. It is, in fact, in the heart of the country of Kentucky. The "tickler" was named in honor of Boone's best friend, a tickler.

The hammer is a flintlock type, the barrel and trigger were designed for wood firing. The weapon was 20 inches with an integral barrel of 20 inches.
