



New Year's

The history

The celebration of the new year is the oldest of all holidays. It was first observed in ancient Babylon about 4000 years ago. In the years around 2000 BC, Babylonians celebrated the beginning of a new year on what is now March 23, although they themselves had no written calendar. Late March actually is a logical choice for the beginning of a new year. It is the time of year that spring begins and new crops are planted. January 1, on the other hand, has no astronomical or agricultural significance. It is purely arbitrary.

Although the Rose Bowl football game was first played as a part of the Tournament of Roses in 1902, it was replaced by Roman chariot races the following year. In 1916, the football game returned as the sports centerpiece of the festival.

It was once believed that the first visitor on New Year's Day would bring either good luck or bad luck the rest of the year. It was particularly lucky if that visitor happened to be a tall dark-haired man.

The song, "Auld Lang Syne," playing in the background, is sang at the stroke of midnight in almost every English-speaking country in the world to bring in the new year.

Early variations of the song were sung prior to 1700 and inspired the author to produce the modern rendition. An old Scotch tune, "Auld Lang Syne" literally means "old long ago," or simply, "the good old days." Here are the lyrics:

Student representation on hold

Board of trustees tables Wethington's proposal to add four more members to presidential search committee

The UK Board of Trustees tabled a proposal to increase the number of representatives on the presidential search committee. The move was considered wise by some members, disturbing to others.

"Increasing the committee from 10 to 14 would outreach the limits of manageability," said Daniel Reedy, board member and professor of Spanish and Italian. "It would be difficult in terms of logistics to get 14 people together for meetings."

Reedy recommended the tabling of the proposal for further study.

Other board members, including Alice Stevens Sparks, share Reedy's fear. Sparks called an increase "unworkable."

Despite the opposition, some board members voiced support for the proposal.

Jimmy Glenn, SGA president and student trustee, spoke in favor of the proposal at the meeting, urging the board not to table it.

"I have a feeling that tabling the proposal would not address the matter," Glenn said.

Others agree.

"There are 20,000 undergraduates and 6,000 graduate students on this campus. The student body ought to be represented," said Russ Williams, staff trustee.

UK President Charles Wethington recommended the committee be expanded from 10 members to 14 members to also include another student representative, an alumni representative, and two additional board members and to replace the community college representative with a staff member.

The committee currently consists of 10 members: five board members, three faculty, one community college representative and one student.

Wethington's proposal maintains the needed 50/50 balance between board members and representatives of the University

community. He based his recommendation on two separate earlier proposals: one by the Student Government Association for the addition of another student to the committee and another by the University Senate to replace the community college representative with a staff member.

The committee on committees will study Wethington's proposal as well as the recommendations from SGA and the University Senate to try to create a new proposal.

If nothing can be compromised, the current 10-member committee will be used.

Wethington told the board there is no reason to rush into a decision because the committee will not be formed until at least spring.

Allied Health breaks ground

College of Allied Health gets new facility to help UK reach top 20 status

The College of Allied Health Professions will soon get a new \$33.5 million building that will assist in UK's goal of becoming a top 20 research university.

"The building will make us the premiere allied health building in the country," said Thomas C. Robinson, dean of the UK College of Allied Health Professions. "It gives us an identity and a research facility."

Robinson said the new facility will aid the college in recruiting prospective students and faculty.

President Charles Wethington was present at the groundbreaking ceremony.

"I assure that this project is bid, sound and ready to go. This is a groundbreaking ceremony for something that is going to happen," Wethington said.

The new building is scheduled for completion in fall 2001.

"This is an important success for UK, Lexington and for people who will be trained in the new facility," said Alan

Grogan, chairperson of the development committee for the College of Allied Health Professions.

Researchers said the new building will enhance laboratory conditions.

"The new quarters will measure a lot. There are a lot of procedures we would like to do now and don't have the resources," said Dr. Doris Baker, associate professor of laboratory science. "The new building will mean we will have space and room for our graduate program."

Students currently enrolled in the program said the new building will give them a better learning environment.

"It will be an improvement to the conditions we are working in now. It will be more of an actual lab setting," said An-chaloe Steele, a clinical laboratory science senior.

"Right now it just feels like a student laboratory and when you get to an actual hospital it's like a culture shock," he said.

"We are in a technology world and a technology time. This (current labs) is behind the times," he said.

HELPING HORSES

New vaccine makes UK ahead of the pack

Last month, horses across the U.S. received an early Christmas present thanks to Tom Chambers and Robert Holland, two researchers from UK's veterinary science department.

On Dec. 3, the U.S. Department of Agriculture licensed the first intranasal equine influenza vaccine, not yet available on the market, which Chambers and Holland had developed in cooperation with University of Pittsburgh virologists Patricia Whitaker-Dowling and Julius Younger.

"This is not a conventional design," Chambers said. "There's no history for equine intranasal flu vaccines."

Chambers explained that currently vaccines for equine influenza are administered in the form of an injection in the neck. However, since the virus resides in the upper respiratory tract and nasal passages, it is not highly effective, he said.

In addition owners complained their horses had reactions such as swelling to the shot. To counteract this, the strength of the shot was lessened.

A horse can be administered the flu shot a number of times and still get the flu, Chambers said.

But Chambers said the new vaccine will work better. The intranasal vaccine does not cause reactions like the shot does, so it can be stronger, he explained. The vaccine also goes straight to the site of infection, making it more effective.

In addition to being the first intranasal vaccine, this new medication was created in a unique fashion. While most vaccines are created from viruses that have been "killed," this vaccine was created from a live virus which Chambers and Holland isolated from a sick horse.

Other researchers have been working on intranasal flu vaccines, but most of them still have some time before producing anything.

"This vaccine is about two years up on the competition," Chambers said.

The vaccine, which was additionally licensed by the FDA in mid-November of last year, is being distributed by the Heka Corporation under the name Flu Avert I.N. Vaccine.

John Steiner, a doctor of veterinary medicine at Haggard, Davidson and McGee, a Lexington equine veterinary firm, said that while the vaccine is not yet available to practicing veterinarians, it appears it will be an improvement over current methods.

"I think it's gonna be used quite a bit," Steiner said.

Chambers doesn't foresee the new vaccine completely eradicating equine influenza, but he does feel it will have an impact.

There is the possibility that within the next five years the vaccine could take the disease from the top of the list of equine respiratory diseases to the bottom, he said.

"The most important aspect of this (vaccine development) is that there is finally an equine flu vaccine that works," Chambers said.

Cats back on track

Jam in Y2K: After an atypical start, Tubby's Wildcats have hit a win streak behind the spark of Jamaal Magloire

Has UK turned around their season? Five straight wins seem to say so. An upset of fifth-ranked Michigan State and a 30-point thrashing of archrival Louisville seem to say so.

Even opposing players and coaches are saying so.

"They may go all the way," said Georgia Tech guard Tony Atkins, following Wednesday's 80-71 Cat victory in Freedom Hall. "When they get together and start playing as a team, they are going to be real good."

"Kentucky is an excellent team," Tech coach Bobby Cremins said. "Kentucky is as good as any team I've seen, and they'll get better."

A man of Cremins' intelligence wouldn't forget that his team has seen No. 1-ranked Stanford, would he?

"People say they're not a super team, but how many super teams are there? I think Kentucky will be there in the end," Cremins responded.

For Kentucky to even be mentioned in the same breath as Arizona, Stanford, UConn and the rest of the national title contenders, some miraculous changes must have taken place. Actually, the changes aren't that miraculous, but they're definitely been for the better.

The smaller lineup. When Wayne Turner graduated, his departure left a void of experienced ball-handlers. Saul Smith has proven to be a capable full-time point guard, but UK's other starting perimeter players — Desmond Allison and Tayshaun Prince — showed they were better off as secondary ball-handlers.

Enter Keith Bogans. The freshman wing player got his first career start against Louisville, and he responded with 12 points and four assists. Many credit this change, with Jules Camara now com-

ing off the bench, as having jump-started Kentucky's latest run. "I think inserting Keith has had a lot to do with that," Tubby Smith said. "Even though he's still learning our system on the defensive end, we've definitely benefited by having an extra ball-handler on the court."

The emergence of J.P. Blevins. Blevins had a breakout game against Michigan State on Dec. 23, canning all three of his three-point attempts and playing such good defense that Smith had no choice but to keep him out there for key minutes.

Tubby showed a lot of confidence in me by playing me down the stretch tonight," Blevins said following the win. "I have been waiting for my opportunity to make an impact and I took advantage of it tonight."

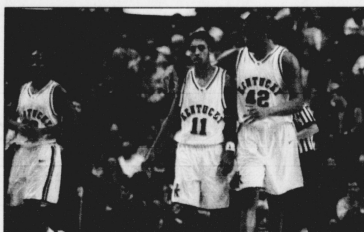
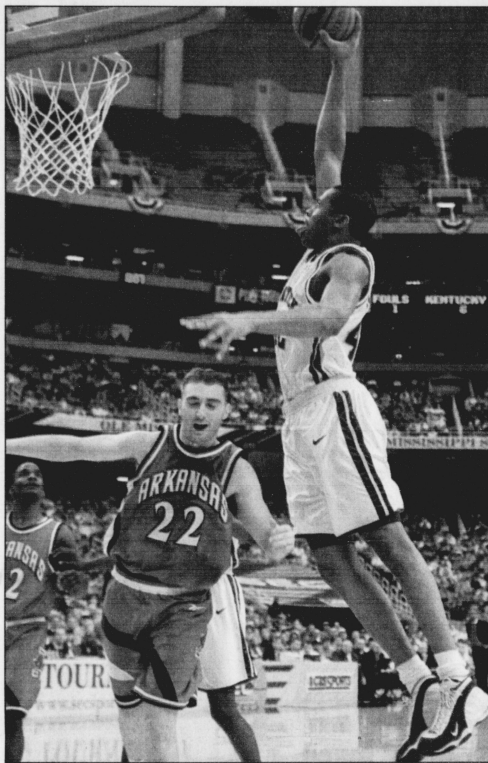
He's continued to take advantage of it in the games since, scoring a total of 23 points in the last three games and seeing nearly 20 minutes per game.

Jamaal Magloire beginning to play like an NBA prospect. The senior big man broke Melvin Turpin's school record for blocked shots in a career during the Louisville game. In the last four games, he shot 52 percent from the floor and 88 percent from the foul line, grabbed about nine rebounds per game and blocked 2.3 shots. He's also averaged 15.3 points per game. For his feat, he was awarded with Southeastern Conference Player of the Week honors this week.

A little addition by subtraction. Forward Nate Knight left the team Tuesday without explanation, but conventional wisdom says it was a combination of homesickness, reduced playing time and a lack of interest in continuing to play college basketball. And Jules Camara, who had talked (albeit casually) about uncertainty surrounding his future, enjoyed a season-high 15 points against Georgia Tech while coming off the bench, a role he

Say 'Hello' to Lexington's latest record label

Listen up: Hello Records brings a new style of doing business to the record industry and a committed record label to Lexington

There's something serious brewing in an unassuming office building on the corner of Limestone and Vine streets. Formed in the fall of 1997, Hello Music, a music label based in Lexington, seems to be solidifying itself as a real force in the biz.

Hello Records released their first offerings — a couple of E.P.s from Lexington bands The .357s and Pleasureville, in the spring of 1998.

"Those E.P.s were used to acquire worldwide distribution and get things rolling," said Stefan Jefferies, president of Hello Music.

Excited people make exciting music and it's apparent that Jefferies has a passion for what he does. Jefferies speaks with a certain intensity as he discusses Hello Records' business plan and breaks down their complex business structure.

With booking offices in Tampa, Fla., and a hip hop/jazz cohort in the Bronx called True Villain Records, Jefferies formed a larger

parent company called Global Music to oversee his numerous projects. Global Music also oversees their expanding Internet presence, for which Jefferies has expansive plans.

"That's what most of our investors are interested in," he said, gesturing to the computer monitor behind him. "You have so many sites out there that have this high value stock and still lose money."

As a label, Hello Music provides its bands with broad exposure through GMG Distribution and GMG Entertainment, while still giving the hands-on attention that only an independent label can provide, Jefferies said.

Hello Music is no slouch about promoting their bands, either. According to a press release, they send each of their band's promotional packages to the CMJ Top 300 radio stations, retail outlets across the United States and select publications for review.

"We have a different style of doing business with our bands," said Jefferies. "That's why bands like L.A.'s Toungue decided to sign with us instead of Geffen or any of the other major's that have been after these guys."

Some of the artists on the label

have already been through the major label ringer and, whether personally or through close friends, have seen how the majors are not as sweet a deal as they seem at first, said Jefferies.

In addition to the complete artistic freedom, Hello Music cuts a very healthy deal with their bands. Where at a major label artists usually receive 5-10% of the profits, Hello Music offers a 50-50 share of the profits from record sales and merchandise.

"Any band you talk to will say that they'd like to make a living playing music," Jefferies said. "We give them the opportunity to do that."

A diversity exists on this label that keeps it from being pigeonholed into this category or that. Hello Music focuses on guitar-oriented rock, but that includes everything from the rock of South 75 to the countrified twang of Pleasureville, and, with True Villain's hip hop, they seem to have all their bases covered.

David Bamberg, mainman of the True Villain branch, said, "When you get away from the pimp-whore mentality of a lot of record labels, the level of respect between the label and the artists increases."



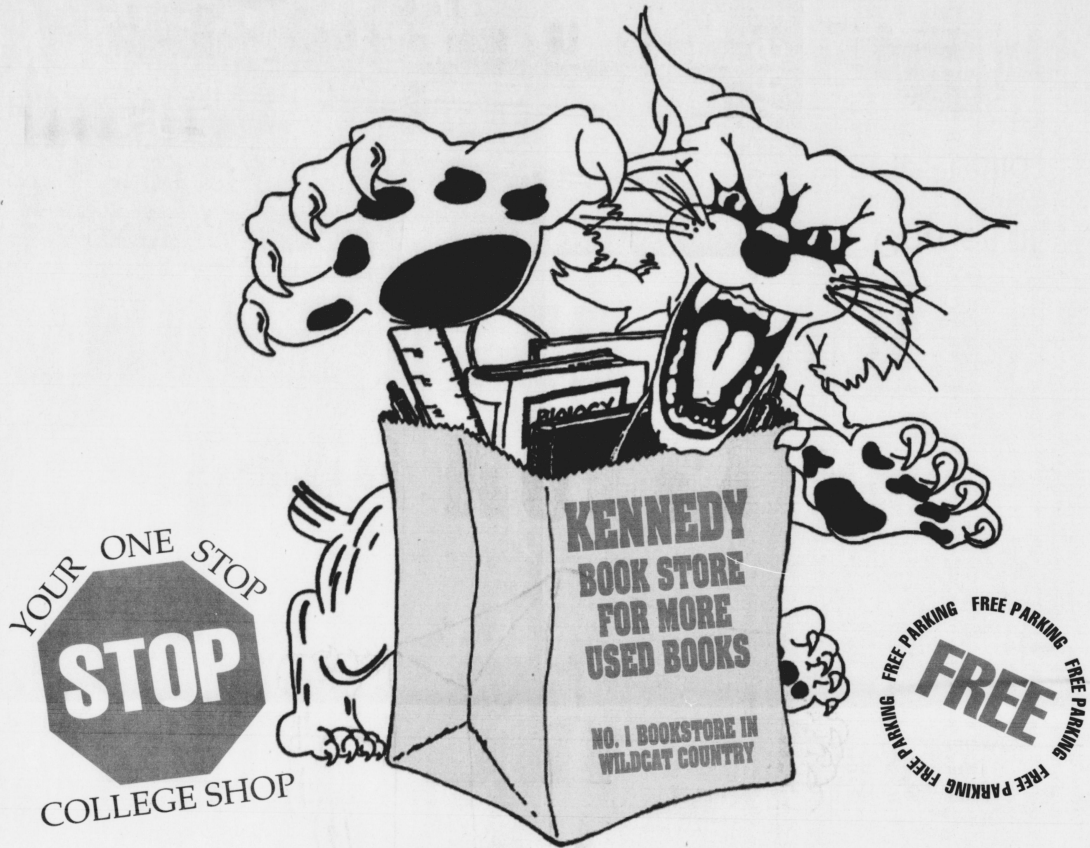

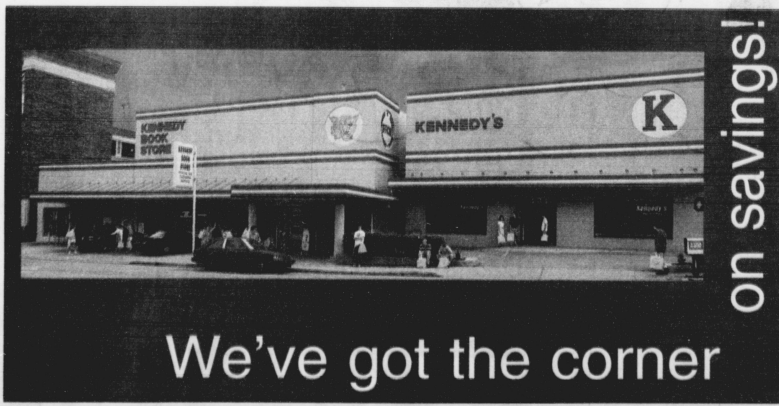
