First time public library service has been taken out in Fayette Co in the 144 years of its life time. *1 of 3 cos. in state with countywide service* Try to use modern marketing psychology.

\$14,000 project sponsored by four civic organizations: Fayette Community Council, Works Progress Administration, Lexington Public Library, and Fayette Co. Board of Education.

Work with purpose of reaching the 22,000 real rural population of Fayette Co. "The better the farmer a man is, the harder it often is for him to find time to get to town to the library." Do they want to read? Have read 21,217 books and magazines during first six months of the library's work.

Use books from three sources:

- Lexington Public Library
- Fayette County Board of Ed. Library in Court house
- Gifts from individuals and Eastern libraries-over 1100
- All magazines circulated are gifts: thousands of them.

Nine centers or book stations ~~are~~ in county. Supplied by from office in basement of Public library.

Trailer to carry books.

Supply magazines to Eastern State; magazines and few books to Reform School.

Unusual library activities:

Boys' reading club with purpose of promoting reading- love of reading by linking up reading with Scouting and 4-H club interests.

Children's radio story hour twice weekly over local station. During March the story hour will be devoted to original stories based on authentic incidents in lives of famous Ky. pioneers.
