At half past eight o'clock A.M., the Faculty convened and was called to order by Pres. Patterson. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

The case of Mr. Wilford White with regard to receiving <sup>the degree of</sup> ~~the degree of~~ ~~Master's~~ ~~of Science~~ ~~of Degree~~ without his having received the Bachelor's at this school, was referred to the Scientific Faculty.

Mr. Blanton on behalf of the Classical Faculty reported that in the case of Mr. Shaw which had come up at the previous meeting, Dr. Pryn would require of him an attendance upon his class in Physiology and Prof. Miller would require him to attend his class in Physiography.

Pres. Patterson called attention to the regulations in regard to monthly reports, and asked the professors to send in their class marks regularly.

The case of Mr. Green regarding his graduation in June of this year, after the secretary had read the correspondence between Prof. Anderson and Mr. Green's father on this subject, was referred to the Deans of the several departments with instructions for them to examine the ~~correspondence~~ more thoroughly and report to the general Faculty on Tuesday Feb. 16, 1897.

Mr. Blanton tendered his resignation as Secretary of the Faculty, and Mr. V. E. Muncy was elected in his stead.
