

RESOLVED: that the officers of the first, second, and third State Regiments, the State Garrison Regiment, The State Artillery Regiment, Clarks and Crockett's Regiments, and Slaughters and Rogers Corps, except so many as are necessary to command the men actually in service, be reduced.

RESOLVED: that the officers and men who are retained in service ought to be consolidated into one or more corps and that as the enlistments of the men expire, a proportionate reduction of the officers ought to be made.

RESOLVED: that all state quartermasters of every denomination of all commissaries either purchases or issuers or belonging to a county ought to be dismissed and that the executive ought to appoint a Quartermaster and Commissary for the Remaining troops.
