the State Garrison Regt<sup>s</sup> the State artillery Regt<sup>s</sup> Clarke & Crockett  
Regiments & Slaughter & Rogers's Corps except so many  
as are necessary to command the men actually in service  
be reduced -- Dec<sup>r</sup> 20 1791

Resolved that the officers & men who are retain<sup>d</sup> in service  
ought to be consolidated into one or more Corps & that as  
the enlistments of the men expire, a proportionate reduction  
of the officers ought to be made Dec<sup>r</sup> 20 1791

Resolved that all state quarter-masters of every denomina-  
-tion & all Commissaries either of Purchases or Issues or  
- belonging to a county ought to be dismissed & that the  
- executive ought to appoint a Quarter Master & Commis-  
- sary for the Remaining troops Dec. 1701
