

Proposition For Arbitration.

1 Each party shall select two brethren mutually acceptable, and the brethren so elected shall choose a fifth who shall act as chairman.

2 This committee shall have power and authority to consider and settle all matters of difference and difficulty affecting the Church relationship of the parties subscribing to this proposition of arbitration.

3 The parties so subscribing shall bind themselves to acquiesce in the recommendations and decisions of the Committee and to use their utmost endeavor to inspire in others the same spirit and course of conduct.

4 It shall be understood that the subscribers do not act officially, but simply as individuals seeking to heal the unhappy breach between brethren who love our common cause.

We accept the above proposition for arbitration and pledge ourselves unconditionally to carry out its provisions.
