James E. Sauer as trustee is
trustee with his wife Li Chi Culver land
by a deed made in 1864. If all the children
of Mr Culver are of age the title can be passed
by a conveyance from the trustee, Mr & Mrs
Culver, and their children, his husband &
wives of such of the children as are mar-
ried joining in the deed.

We find conveyances from several parties
to Culver aggregating about ^{ninety} one hundred
acres of land. Besides certain undivided
interests in a down tract of about 41
acres. We find that he has sold say 79
acres. One of this 79 acres he claims that
the down tract was a part - thus leaving
about 51 acres in his name. We cannot
tell from the record whether the down
was included in the land sold or is
still in the hands of his trustee as
