Covenant breaking - After agreeing to abide by the decision of the Board with reference to the rent of the farm, (the Board deciding against him,) he still endeavored to hold possession of the same, and materially interfered with the Committee in their renting it out.

Second

After the Executive Committee had advertised and sold stock, crop and other personal property of the University in accordance with the direction of the Board of Curators, he (Bowman) took forcible possession of a part of the property after it had been sold and delivered to parties who purchased it at the sale. He also bought a part of the property himself and has so far failed to pay for or execute bond for the same.

Third

Refusal to give information to the Executive as to the sale he (Bowman) made of United States Bonds, the amount realized on same, to whom sold, and what application was made of the proceeds.

Fourth

Refusal to give security for about Five Hundred (\$500<sup>00</sup>) dollars collect of endowment fund collected from P. W. Bishop, the same being still in Bowman's hands and still unsecured.
