Herewith please find
an on Bond of Abbeville for \$90⁰⁰ issued by Judge
Gordon on note due April 6th 1889 for \$450⁰⁰ pay-
able to W. J. Winters.

Judge Gordon wants to pay bal of face of
the note in settlement of same. He says he
would be glad to pay the note in full, but he
is not able, that the horse bought was a total loss
to him, and he has absolutely no property to
pay same with.

If you should deem prudent to accept his
offer there would be coming to you under these
terms after this payment of \$210⁰⁰ on the \$450⁰⁰
note. I will in any event require him to
pay expenses of collection. His offer, as you will
see, is near 50% of what you are due.

I would be glad to be able to collect every dol-
lar due on this note, and dare say if Judge Gordon
was able he would rather pay entire sum than
